Regarding: Tyre marking and Rally 2	

1. Tyre markings are scheduled after the following time controls.

- 1. TC0(Start of the rally)
- 2. TC4C(Regroup out)
- 3. TC7B(Service B out)
- 4. TC9D(Service D out)
- 5. TC13C(Service E out))

2. The side wall of four tyres fitted will be marked. For spare tyres, "unused marking" will be done on the treads.

*Spare tyres with no tyre marking on the side wall may be used without declaration.

*All the tyres fitted must satisfied the regulations (ie. the depth the grooves) even after the use.

3. Tyre marking will be checked before the following time controls.

- 1. TC4A(Service A in)
- 2. TC7A(Regroup in)
- 3. TC9A(Service C in)
- 4. TC13A(Regroup in)
- 5. TC17A(Service F in)

*The scrutineers may check the depth of the grooves at anytime.

* An authorisation must be granted from the chief scrutineer for changing rims (in case of broken rim for instance)

4. Re-scrutineering for Rally 2

4-1. The JSR crew who wish Rally 2 must have their car re-scrutineered after applying for Rally 2 application to the Clerk of the Course. Re-scrutineering will be held until 20:00 on the 9th JUN(SAT) or alternatively after 07:00 to 30 minutes prior to their start time on the 10th JUN.

4-2. The JRC crew who wish Rally 2 must have their car re-scrutineered after applying for Rally 2 application to the Clerk of the Course. Re-scrutineering will be held until 21:00 on the 9th JUN(SAT) or alternatively between 07:00 and 07:45 on the 10th JUN.

Re-scrutineering will be held at the scrutineering tent in the service park.
